**Golf at Thousand Oaks Golf Course – 12:00 p.m. – 5:30 p.m.
(Pace of play will determine actual time)**

Thousand Oaks Golf Club, is one of Michigan's premier golf destinations. Golf Digest has rated this Rees Jones signature course "4 ½ stars Places to Play" and one of the 25 best golf courses in Michigan.

This stunning piece of property will give you the feeling of a classic Northern Michigan-style golf course, located just minutes from downtown Grand Rapids. Thousand Oaks is designed to provide a challenging test of golf, while accommodating golfers of all skill levels.



With four sets of tee markers on each hole, the course can play anywhere from 5,328 to 7,128 yards. You are promised not only to have a memorable golfing experience, but also the opportunity to take in great sights, sounds, and animal life found at Thousand Oaks Golf Club.

Jeep/Sand Dune Adventure – 12:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.

Silver Lake State Park is an almost 3,000-acre park in Oceana County along the Lake Michigan shoreline. This area includes both dune country and acres of mature forest. The dune ridges and valleys are mostly windblown sand and lack trees, scrub brush and dune grass. The dune area is sometimes compared to a desert. Silver Lake State Park contains more than four miles of Lake Michigan shoreline and boasts a large sandy beach.

Up to five people per Jeep...guests drive!

A guide will lead the group through Jeep trails through the Sand Dunes (groups can switch drivers half way through). After the one hour Jeep tour, head out on the dunes in dune buggies or quads.

Includes:

- Jeeps (up to 5 people per Jeep), dune buggies (2 people per buggy), quads (1 person per quad)

Requirements:

- Drivers must have a valid driver's license (and, to drive Jeeps, must have auto insurance).

Grand Rapids/Kent Trail Bike Tour – 1:00 p.m. - 4:00 pm

This guided ride will take bikers from the JW Marriott past Grand Valley State University campus and along the Grand River to John Ball Park Zoo. At this point, the bikers will pick up the Kent Trail and head toward Millennium Park.
